10	Canal Locks	Instructors & Group	Medium	<ul> <li>Brief to keep away from locks when in use.</li> <li>Do not use the locks at all</li> </ul>	Low
11	Hypo/hyperthermia	Instructors & group	Medium	<ul> <li>Instructors should ensure that the group is appropriately clothed for the weather (e.g. Waterproofs, hat, gloves, warm clothes, sun-lotion etc.)</li> <li>Instructors should ensure that group is appropriately hydrated and monitor the state of all individuals within the group.</li> <li>Instructors should be prepared to stop or have a break during the session.</li> <li>Group needs safety bag readily available.
