No	Hazard	Who it effects	Unmanaged Risk	Control Measures	Managed Risk
1	Cutting fingers when using scissors	Group.	Mediem	Advise group to be careful and aware of what they cut with scissors. Only use children's safety scissors.	Low
2	Damage to people or property when the projectile is released	Group.	Medium	Instructor to make people aware of group members in front of the egg drop area when it is about to be released. Drop egg straight down, do not throw.	Low
3	Slips, trips and falls.	Group.	Medium	Advise group to be aware and take care when moving around the area where the eggs are being dropped, and when climbing up the stairs to the drop zone.	Low
4	Salmonella.	Group.	Medium	Warn people to be aware of the hazard, wash hands when finished, clean up any broken eggs thoroughly.	Low
5	Allergies to eggs or balloons	Group.	High	Teaching staff to inform Carlton Lodge of any allergies prior to arrival. Depending on severity of the allergy either offer alternative sessions or individuals avoid contact with items they are allergic to by wearing gloves etc.	Low
